If PARDOVAN, KINGSCAVIL AND WINCHBURGH were a village of 100 people...

 - 24 who have no qualifications; 16 who have a University degree
 - 33 who work full time; 13 who are retired
- > 90 would describe themselves as 'White Scottish'
- > 5 would describe their health as bad or very bad
- > 9 would be providing unpaid care
- > 34 would say they belonged to the Church of Scotland

If PARDOVAN, KINGSCAVIL AND WINCHBURGH were a village of 100 households...


- > 32 households would consist of one person, 13 of whom are aged 65 and over

Population Breakdown by Religion






Church of Scotland Statistics for Mission Group

Population Breakdown by Ethnicity/Language









Household composition




