If ROGART were a village of 100 people...

- > 7 would be in primary school; 5 would be in high school
- > 14 would be aged between 25 and 44
- > 29 would be aged 65 or over
- > 72 would be of working age (16-74), including
 - 26 who have no qualifications; 22 who have a University degree
 - 21 who work full time; 19 who are retired
- > 73 would describe themselves as 'White Scottish'
- > 4 would describe their health as bad or very bad
- > 9 would be providing unpaid care
- > 45 would say they belonged to the Church of Scotland

If ROGART were a village of 100 households...


- > 38 households would consist of one person, 16 of whom are aged 65 and over
- > 18 would have have dependent children (aged under 16, or under 18 in full-time education)
- > 22 would be in rented accomodation
- > 89 would have access to at least one car or van
- > 4 would speak a language other than English in the home



Population Breakdown by Ethnicity/Language
















