#### If STRATH & SLEAT were a village of 100 people...

- > 8 would be in primary school; 4 would be in high school
- > 22 would be aged between 25 and 44
- > 18 would be aged 65 or over
- > 76 would be of working age (16-74), including
  - 16 who have no qualifications; 30 who have a University degree
  - 24 who work full time; 14 who are retired
- > 72 would describe themselves as 'White Scottish'
- > 4 would describe their health as bad or very bad
- > 9 would be providing unpaid care
- > 35 would say they belonged to the Church of Scotland

#### If STRATH & SLEAT were a village of 100 households...


- > 34 households would consist of one person, 11 of whom are aged 65 and over





### **Population Breakdown by Ethnicity/Language**












## Economic activity of those of working age (1)




